

## Question for Colorado Attorney General Phil Weiser

3-24-22

Your talk today is about how your office protects consumers and responds to bad actors.

On March 22, two days ago, the 3<sup>rd</sup> Forensic Report from MESA County was made public. Over the past few days, I have read the findings of all three of these reports, and a 4<sup>th</sup> report from Antrim County, Michigan.

It seems clear that the SOS, Jena Griswold, and Dominion Voting Systems staff, destroyed election data, at least 29,000 files, Griswold certified voting machines that were not secure, there is undeniable evidence that these voting machines were used to alter the vote count, these computers have 36 wireless access devices that can be accessed by any computer and even by an Iphone, connected to unauthorized networks, and the internet.

The Antrim Michigan study concluded that the Dominion Voting System is intentionally and purposefully designed...to create systemic fraud and influence election results.

These three Mesa County reports would not exist if it were not for the courageous actions by the Mesa County Clerks, yet I have read that you have helped to convene a grand jury that has indicted both the Mesa County Clerk, Tina Peters, and her deputy clerk, Sherrona Bishop and charged them with 10 and 6 counts respectively of criminal activity.

Yet these 4 reports clearly identify the major criminal activity has been done by Griswold and Dominion. The Mesa clerks appear to have done there best to protect the vote records even when this required disobeying the SOS. It is clear to me that you should be going after the SOS and Dominion, not the Mesa clerks. Rather than your office going after the “bad actors,” you have gone after the heroes. You appear to be covering up major crimes and refusing to go after the real criminals, Griswold and Dominion. If you and your office continue to go after the good actors and not the bad, you could end up finding yourselves in jail for protecting these criminals. Am I right?
